SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland (as enacted by Chapters 165 and 558 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1974) 1974 and Chapter (H.B. 523) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1982) read(s) as follows:

## Article 56 - Licenses

## Cosmetologists

549 <u>500</u>.

All examination fees shall be five dollars (\$5.00), and the registration fees for the issuance of licenses, with or without examination, shall be as follows:

- (a) Twenty dollars (\$20.00) for beauty shop owners, managers and teachers, [annual] BIENNIAL renewal fee of [twenty dollars (\$20.00)] \$40.
- (b) {Annual}--BIENNIAL--renewal--fee--ef--five FIVE dollars (\$5.00)-}- AND BIENNIAL RENEWAL FEE OF \$10 for operators, manicurists, cosmeticians, wig stylists, and demonstrators.
- (c) Two dollars (\$2.00) for students and apprentices, -f-annual-}-BHENNIAL renewal fee of two dollars (\$2.00).
- (d) One hundred dollars (\$100.00) for schools of beauty culture. Public and parochial schools, however, are hereby declared to be exempted from the payment of any license fees, but are subject to the other provisions of this subtitle. [Annual] BIENNIAL renewal fees shall be the same-as-registration except-in-the-ease-of-schools-which shall-be [fifty dollars (\$50.00)] \$100.
- (e) Five dollars (\$5.00) for cosmetologist-aide, [annual] BIENNIAL renewal fee of [five dollars (\$5.00)] \$10.
  - (f) One dollar (\$1.00) for temporary license.

The above fees for registration, examination and certification shall be paid in advance to the secretary of the Board.
