expiration of the grace period, the Board may renew such a certificate upon the payment of [\$50] \$100 to the Board. No person who applies for renewal, whose certificate was suspended for failure to renew shall be required to submit to any examination as a condition of renewal.

Article 56 - Licenses

Home Improvement Law

254.

- (a) An applicant may not be scheduled for an examination required by this subtitle until the applicant has paid a nonrefundable examination fee of \$10.
- (b) No license may be issued or become effective until the applicant pays the fee therefor as follows:
- (1) Contractor's license, for each business location, [for each year] FOR--2--YEARS-or part-thereof; including the fee for one salesman's license..-{-\$75-}--\$150 ...BIENNIAL RENEWAL \$150
- (2) Salesman's license, [for each year] FOR--2

 ...BIENNIAL RENEWAL \$70
- (4) Fifteen dollars of these fees are not refundable to cover the cost of processing the applicant's eligibility.
 - (c) Fees shall be collected as follows:

- (h) Unless revoked or suspended by the Commission a license shall expire on June 30 [following the date of issue] OF EACH ODD-NUMBERED YEAR and may be [annually] BIENNIALLY renewed upon payment of all required fees.
