(Senate Bill 194)

AN ACT concerning

Guardian of the Person

FOR the purpose of ~~requiring that each guardian submit an annual report to the court,~~ requiring a law enforcement officer to transport a person to a health care facility in certain emergencies; providing that a court hear a petition for the appointment of a guardian within 60 days; providing for a procedure for investigations in certain circumstances; and providing for the review by the Disabled Persons Review Board of guardianship held by public agencies.
