CHAPTER 794

(Senate Bill 270)

AN ACT concerning

Pensions - Boards of Supervisors of Elections -
Employees

FOR the purpose of providing that employees of the Boards of Supervisors of Elections may obtain service credit for certain prior service ~~if the reserves for the credit are paid by the employer~~ ; and providing for the payment of the reserves to fund such service credit.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article 73B - Pensions

3.

The membership of the retirement system shall consist of the following:

(6) (a) All full-time and part-time permanent employees of the boards of supervisors of elections of the counties and in Baltimore City shall become members of the Employees' Retirement System of the State of Maryland as a condition of employment, except those board employees who have elected to remain in the local merit system under the provisions of § 9G of Article 64A of this Code. Employees who become members of the Employees' Retirement System under this subsection may receive credit for any service performed with the county or Baltimore City prior to January 1, 1972, if the reserves for this credit are paid by the employee during the year in which the employee retires, except for credit transferred under §§ 31 through 34 of this article.
