8-511. CONFIDENTIALITY.

(A) IDENTITY AND RECORDS.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE IDENTITY OF AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS IN A CENTER, FACILITY, OR PROGRAM UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, AND THE REGISTRATION AND OTHER RECORDS OF THE CENTER, FACILITY, OR PROGRAM ARE CONFIDENTIAL.

(B) DISCLOSURES.

THE IDENTITY OF THE INDIVIDUAL MAY BE DISCLOSED, WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE INDIVIDUAL, ONLY TO:

- (1) THE FAMILY OF THE INDIVIDUAL;
- (2) STAFF WHO WORK WITH THE INDIVIDUAL UNDER THIS TITLE;
- (3) POLICE PERSONNEL INVESTIGATING A CRIMINAL OFFENSE OR A COMPLAINT ABOUT POLICE ACTION; OR
- (4) COURT OR CORRECTIONAL PERSONNEL FOR PROCEDURES THAT RELATE TO A TRIAL, AN APPEAL, OR A PROBATION, PAROLE, OR PRESENTENCE REPORT.

8-601. SHORT TITLE.

THIS TITLE MAY BE CITED AS THE "MARYLAND INTOXICATION AND ALCOHOLISM ACT".
