- (B) TO-APPLY-FOR-A-REFUND, -AN-APPLICANT-SHALL:
- (1)--Fibe--A--CLAIM--FOR--REFUND--ON-THE-FORM-THE COMPTROLLER-REQUIRES,-AND
- (2)--FURNISH-THE-INFORMATION-THAT-THE-COMPTROLLER REQUIRES-TO-VERIFY-THAT-THE-STAMPS-ARE-OF-A--TYPE--DESCRIBED IN-SUBSECTION-(A)-OF-THIS-SECTION:

NO CLAIM SHALL BE ALLOWED UNDER THIS SECTION UNLESS:

- (1) <u>1</u>#--IS-FILED THE CLAIMANT FILES THE CLAIM ON FORMS PRESCRIBED BY THE COMPTROLLER WITHIN 6 MONTHS OF THE DATE THE STAMPS WERE MISAPPLIED, CANCELLED, OR DESTROYED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (A) (1)-THROUGH-(6) OF THIS SECTION; AND
- THE COMPTROLLER THAT THE CLAIMANT WAS NOT INDEMNIFIED BY ANY VALID CLAIM OF INSURANCE OR IS OTHERWISE ENTITLED TO INDEMNIFICATION FOR THE MISAPPLICATION, CANCELLATION, OR DESTRUCTION OF THE STAMPS; AND
- THE COMPTROLLER MAY REQUIRE TO VERIFY THAT THE STAMPS ARE OF THE TYPE DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION; AND
- \$250 WITH RESPECT TO STAMPS LOST OR DESTROYED IN THIS STATE BECAUSE OF FIRE, FLOOD, OTHER DISASTER, VANDALISM, OR MALICIOUS MISCHIEF.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.

Public Education - State Aid

FOR the purpose of altering the fiscal year used to calculate the State share of basic current expenses to public education; providing that certain State aid may not-be-less-than-aid-received during a certain fiscal
