AN ACT concerning

Workmen's Compensation -- Professional Sports Injuries

~~FOR the purpose of including certain injuries to professional athletes as compensable injuries under Workmen's Compensation providing that a sudden injury to a player-employee which was not intended by the player-employee and which arises out of and in the course of employment with a professional sports team domiciled in this State shall be compensable under certain conditions.~~

FOR the purpose of providing that compensation under the Workmen's Compensation law may not be denied because of the degree of risk associated with the employment.
