(d) The term "incorporated municipality" as used in subsection (b) of this section shall mean the territory within the limits of an incorporated city or town within any county of this State or of Baltimore City. However, this term shall not be construed to include any other territory within the limits of any county.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
