Preamble

WHEREAS, The Maryland Mobile Home Parks Act of 1980 has been enacted for the protection of citizens of this State; and

WHEREAS, The Act presently relies on individual civil action which is costly and impracticable for too many citizens; and

WHEREAS, Supervision of the provisions of this Act may be efficiently carried out by the State's Consumer Protection Division; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 8A-1802 of Article - Real Property, of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 8A-1803.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article - Real Property

8A-1802.

THE-DIVISION-OF-CONSUMER-PROTECTION-OF-THE-OFFICE-OF THE-ATTORNEY-CENERAL-SHALL-ENFORCE-THIS-TITLE:

- (A) TO THE EXTENT THAT A VIOLATION OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS TITLE AFFECTS A RESIDENT OR PROSPECTIVE RESIDENT, THAT VIOLATION SHALL BE WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE ENFORCEMENT DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE DIVISION OF CONSUMER PROTECTION OF THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, AS DESCRIBED IN TITLE 13 OF THE COMMERCIAL LAW ARTICLE.
- (B) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE SHALL OTHERWISE BE ENFORCED BY EACH AGENCY OF THE STATE WITHIN THE SCOPE OF ITS AUTHORITY.
