

THE DIRECTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CARRYING OUT THE POWERS, DUTIES, AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE ADMINISTRATION.

(B) POWERS.

IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS SET FORTH ELSEWHERE IN THIS TITLE, THE DIRECTOR MAY:

(1) WITHIN THE AMOUNTS MADE AVAILABLE BY APPROPRIATION, GIFT, OR GRANT, MAKE ANY AGREEMENT OR JOINT FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT TO DO OR HAVE DONE ANYTHING NECESSARY, DESIRABLE, OR PROPER TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES OF THIS TITLE; AND

(2) WITHIN THE AMOUNTS MADE AVAILABLE BY APPROPRIATION, EMPLOY A STAFF.

(C) DUTIES.

IN ADDITION TO THE DUTIES SET FORTH ELSEWHERE IN THIS TITLE, THE DIRECTOR SHALL:

(1) ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE;

(2) SURVEY AND ANALYZE THE NEEDS OF THIS STATE FOR PREVENTION, DIAGNOSIS, AND CONTROL OF DRUG ABUSE AND FOR TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION OF DRUG ABUSERS;

(3) WITH THE ADVICE OF THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL, REVISE THE STATE COMPREHENSIVE DRUG ABUSE CONTROL PLAN, FROM TIME TO TIME, AS TO:

(I) THE LONG-RANGE DEVELOPMENT OF ADEQUATE SERVICES AND FACILITIES TO MEET THESE NEEDS; AND

(II) THE USE OF FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL, AND PRIVATE RESOURCES IN THIS DEVELOPMENT;

(4) GIVE OUT INFORMATION ON SERVICES AND FACILITIES IN THIS STATE THAT ARE AVAILABLE TO HELP DRUG ABUSERS AND POTENTIAL DRUG ABUSERS;

(5) PREPARE AND SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY AN ANNUAL BUDGET REQUEST;

(6) SUBMIT:

(I) AN ANNUAL REPORT TO THE SECRETARY, THE GOVERNOR, AND THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND

(II) ANY ADDITIONAL REPORT THAT THE SECRETARY, GOVERNOR, OR GENERAL ASSEMBLY REQUESTS; AND
