- (2) (3) THE ZONING OFFICIAL MAY DELIVER A CITATION TO A PERSON BELIEVED TO BE COMMITTING A CIVIL ZONING VIOLATION. A COPY OF THE CITATION SHALL BE RETAINED BY THE ZONING OFFICIAL AND SHALL BEAR A CERTIFICATION ATTESTING TO THE TRUTH OF THE MATTERS SET FORTH. THE CITATION SHALL CONTAIN:
- (I) THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE PERSON CHARGED;
  - (II) THE NATURE OF THE VIOLATION;
- (III) THE PLACE WHERE AND TIME THAT THE VIOLATION OCCURRED;
  - (IV) THE AMOUNT OF THE FINE ASSESSED;
- (V) THE MANNER, LOCATION, AND TIME IN WHICH THE FINE MAY BE PAID; AND
- (VI) THE PERSON'S RIGHT TO ELECT TO STAND TRIAL FOR THE VIOLATION.
- (3) (4) A PRESET FINE, NOT TO EXCEED \$500, MAY BE IMPOSED FOR EACH VIOLATION. THE LOCAL LEGISLATIVE BODY MAY ESTABLISH A SCHEDULE OF FINES FOR EACH VIOLATION AND MAY ADOPT PROCEDURES FOR COLLECTION OF THESE FINES.
