

(4) TO INFLUENCE THE ISSUANCE, AMENDMENT, OR REVOCATION OF ANY EXECUTIVE ORDER OR SIMILAR PROMULGATION BY ANY FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL AGENCY, OR TO UNDERTAKE TO INFLUENCE THE PASSAGE OR DEFEAT OF ANY LEGISLATION BY THE CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES, OR BY ANY STATE OR LOCAL LEGISLATIVE BODIES, OR STATE PROPOSALS BY REFERENDUM BY PETITION, EXCEPT WHERE;

(i) REPRESENTATION BY AN EMPLOYEE OF A GRANTEE OF AN ELIGIBLE CLIENT IS NECESSARY TO THE PROVISION OF LEGAL ADVICE AND REPRESENTATION WITH RESPECT TO SUCH CLIENT'S LEGAL RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES, OR

(ii) A GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY, LEGISLATIVE BODY, A COMMITTEE, OR A MEMBER THEREOF

1. REQUESTS PERSONNEL OF THE GRANTEE TO TESTIFY, DRAFT, OR REVIEW MEASURES OR TO MAKE REPRESENTATIONS TO SUCH AGENCY, BODY, COMMITTEE, OR

2. IS CONSIDERING A MEASURE DIRECTLY AFFECTING THE ACTIVITIES OF THE GRANTEE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE,

(5) TO CONTRIBUTE TO OR BE MADE AVAILABLE TO ANY POLITICAL PARTY OR ASSOCIATION, OR THE CAMPAIGN OF ANY CANDIDATE FOR PUBLIC OR PARTY OFFICE; OR

(6) TO PROVIDE REPRESENTATION IN A CLASS ACTION SUIT WITHOUT THE EXPRESS APPROVAL OF THE PROJECT DIRECTOR OF THE GRANTEE IN ACCORDANCE WITH POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE GRANTEE.

45K. AUDITS.

(A) ANNUAL AUDITS.

(1) THE ACCOUNTS OF THE CORPORATION SHALL BE AUDITED ANNUALLY. THESE AUDITS SHALL BE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH GENERALLY ACCEPTED AUDITING STANDARDS BY INDEPENDENT CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANTS.

(2) THE AUDITS SHALL BE CONDUCTED AT THE PLACE OR PLACES WHERE THE ACCOUNTS OF THE CORPORATION ARE NORMALLY KEPT. ALL BOOKS, ACCOUNTS, FINANCIAL RECORDS, REPORTS, FILES, AND OTHER PAPERS OR PROPERTY BELONGING TO OR IN USE BY THE CORPORATION AND NECESSARY TO FACILITATE THE AUDITS SHALL BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PERSON OR PERSONS CONDUCTING THE AUDITS. FULL FACILITIES FOR VERIFYING TRANSACTIONS WITH THE BALANCES AND SECURITIES HELD BY DEPOSITORIES, FISCAL AGENTS, AND CUSTODIANS SHALL BE AVAILABLE TO THE AUDITORS.

(3) THE REPORT OF THE ANNUAL AUDIT SHALL BE FILED WITH THE GOVERNOR, GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AND THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING AND SHALL BE
