9-402. FACILITIES AND SERVICES.

(A) IN GENERAL.

THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:

(1) COORDINATE THE FACILITIES AND SERVICES THAT OFFER TREATMENT, CARE, OR REHABILITATION FOR DRUG ABUSERS; AND

(2) ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT SET:

(I) REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTIFICATION OF THESE FACILITIES AND SERVICES; AND

(II) STANDARDS FOR TREATMENT AND CONDITIONS OF INPATIENT CARE AND AFTERCARE.

(B) OPERATION OR DESIGNATION.

THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ESTABLISH AND OPERATE OR SHALL DESIGNATE THESE FACILITIES AND SERVICES, INCLUDING MEDICAL EXAMINATION FACILITIES:

(1) TO DETERMINE IF AN ALLEGED DRUG ABUSER IS A DRUG ABUSER; AND

(2) TO PROVIDE CARE AND CUSTODY OF AN ALLEGED DRUG ABUSER FOR WHOM A COURT PROCEEDING IS PENDING.

(C) GENERAL POWERS.

THE ADMINISTRATION MAY:

(1) EMPLOY, REMOVE AT WILL, AND, WITHIN THE AMOUNTS MADE AVAILABLE BY APPROPRIATION, SET THE COMPENSATION OF AN ADMINISTRATIVE HEAD OF ANY FACILITY THAT THE ADMINISTRATION OPERATES UNDER THIS SUBTITLE; AND

(2) WITHIN THE AMOUNTS MADE AVAILABLE BY
