Also in subsection (c)(2) of this section, the former reference to a "devise or gift" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the definition of "gift" in Article 1, § 22 of the Code.

9-403. CERTIFICATION REQUIRED.

A PERSON OR PUBLIC BODY SHALL BE CERTIFIED BY THE ADMINISTRATION BEFORE THE PERSON OR BODY MAY TREAT AN INDIVIDUAL WHO SEEKS TREATMENT FOR DRUG ABUSE OR MAY OFFER TO THE INDIVIDUAL ANY TREATMENT, SERVICE, OR METHOD OF REHABILITATION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the first sentence of Article 43B, § 19(a).

The defined term "person" is substituted for the reference to a "facility, institution, organization or individual, private".

The former reference to "drug addiction" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the broad reference to "drug abuse".

9-404. SAME -- QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS; APPLICATIONS FOR CERTIFICATION; ISSUANCE AND DENIAL.

(A) QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS.

TO QUALIFY FOR CERTIFICATION TO TREAT DRUG ABUSERS, AN APPLICANT SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS THAT THE ADMINISTRATION ADOPTS.
