(F) (E) ANY VOLUNTEER OR PAID FIRE COMPANY OR RESCUE SQUAD MAY CONSIDER THE EXISTENCE OF A CRIMINAL CONVICTION IN DETERMINING WHETHER OR NOT AN APPLICANT WILL BE APPOINTED OR EMPLOYED.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
