(A) THE CLERK OF EACH CIRCUIT COURT SHALL SUBMIT ANNUALLY A BUDGET FOR THE REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

(B) EACH BUDGET SUBMITTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL:

(1) SPECIFY FOR EACH CLERK'S OFFICE:

- (I) THE NUMBER OF POSITIONS;
- (II) THE SALARIES;
- (III) THE EXPENSES; AND
- (IV) THE ANTICIPATED REVENUES.

(2) BE SUBMITTED TO THE COMPTROLLER IN A UNIFORM FORMAT AS PRESCRIBED BY THE SECRETARY OF BUDGET AND FISCAL PLANNING; AND

(3) BE SUBJECT TO REVIEW BY THE COMPTROLLER AND THE STATE COURT ADMINISTRATOR; AND

(3) (4) BE INCLUDED IN THE STATE BUDGET AS PART OF THE BUDGET FOR THE ~~COMPTROLLER OF THE TREASURY~~ EXECUTIVE BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT.

(C) THE GOVERNOR MAY INCLUDE IN THE STATE BUDGET FUNDS TO SUPPLEMENT THE FEES AND RECEIPTS OF THE CLERKS OF THE CIRCUIT COURTS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, as used in this Act, "Circuit Court" includes the respective courts of the Supreme Bench of Baltimore City and the circuit court for any other county.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
