- (C) (1) IN HOWARD COUNTY THE APPLICANTS FOR A NEW LICENSE OR THE TRANSFER OF AN EXISTING LICENSE FOR THE USE OF A CORPORATION SHALL CERTIFY THAT THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS SHALL BE MAINTAINED AS LONG AS THE I.ICENSEE IS THE HOLDER OF THE LICENSE:
