CHAPTER 872

(House Bill 1074)

AN ACT concerning

Police and Court Records - Expungement

FOR the purpose of providing that certain persons who have been granted a full and unconditional pardon by the Governor may file a petition for expungement of certain records under certain circumstances; and generally relating to expungement of police and court records.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

(F) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "CRIME OF VIOLENCE" IS AS DEFINED IN § 643B(A) OF THIS ARTICLE.

737.

(a) If a person is charged with the commission of a crime and
