9-620. PETITION.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IF IT IS BELIEVED THAT AN INDIVIDUAL IS A DRUG ADDICT, PETITION FOR COMMITMENT OF THE INDIVIDUAL TO THE ADMINISTRATION MAY BE MADE, AS PROVIDED IN PART III OF THIS SUBTITLE, BY:

(1) THE INDIVIDUAL'S SPOUSE, PARENT, SIBLING, OR CHILD;

(2) IN THE ABSENCE OF THESE RELATIVES, THE NEXT NEAREST RELATIVE OF THE INDIVIDUAL;

(3) ANYONE WHO LIVES IN THE SAME HOUSE AS THE INDIVIDUAL; OR

(4) ANY PHYSICIAN.

(B) JURISDICTION AND VENUE.

A PETITION UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE FILED WITH THE DISTRICT COURT IN OR CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE COUNTY WHERE THE ALLEGED DRUG ADDICT RESIDES OR OTHERWISE MAY BE FOUND.

(C) PETITION.

A PETITION UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL:

(1) BE SIGNED AND VERIFIED BY THE PETITIONER;

(2) STATE THE PETITIONER'S:

(I) NAME;

(II) TITLE;

(III) ADDRESS; AND

(IV) RELATIONSHIP TO THE ALLEGED DRUG ADDICT;

(3) STATE THE ALLEGED DRUG ADDICT'S:

(I) NAME;
