- (I) PERFORMS WITH EXCEPTIONAL INDUSTRY, APPLICATION, AND SKILL ANY INDUSTRIAL, AGRICULTURAL, OR ADMINISTRATIVE TASK ASSIGNED TO THE PARTICIPANT; OR
- (II) PERFORMS WITH SATISFACTORY INDUSTRY, APPLICATION, AND PROGRESS IN ANY PROGRAM TO WHICH THE PARTICIPANT IS ASSIGNED;
- (6) AFTER AN ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING, CANCEL ANY REDUCTION IN SENTENCE EARNED BY ANY PARTICIPANT WHO VIOLATES ANY RULE OR REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- (D) (1) THE ADMINISTRATOR SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CONDUCT ANY PROGRAM. IN ADOPTING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS, THE ADMINISTRATOR SHALL CONSIDER:
  - (I) THE SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC; AND
- (II) THE SECURITY OF ANY ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY DETENTION FACILITY.
- (2) IF ANY CONDITION OF SENTENCE IMPOSED ON A PRISONER BY A JUDGE IS INCONSISTENT WITH ANY RULE OR REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION, THE JUDICIALLY IMPOSED CONDITION CONTROLS AS TO THAT PRISONER.
- (E) ANY PRISONER WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF OR FAILS TO PERFORM ANY DUTY IMPOSED BY A RULE OR REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION IS SUBJECT TO:
  - (1) REMOVAL FROM THE PROGRAM;
- (2) AFTER AN ADMINISTRATIVE HEARING CANCELLATION OF ANY EARNED DIMINUTION OF SENTENCE; AND
- (3) FOR WILLFUL FAILURE TO RETURN TO THE ASSIGNED DETENTION FACILITY IN VIOLATION OF ANY RULE OR REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, PROSECUTION UNDER § 139 OF THIS ARTICLE (ESCAPING-FROM-PENITENTIARY)-AND-UPON CONVICTION, TRANSFER-TO-THE-CUSTODY-OF-THE-PENITENTIARY-OR HOUSE-OF-CORRECTION-FOR-THE-DURATION-OF-INCARCERATION.
- (F) (1) THE-DIVISION-OF-PAROLE-AND-PROBATION THE ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS DESIGNEE SHALL COLLECT EACH PARTICIPANT'S TOTAL EARNINGS, LESS PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS. FROM THE EARNINGS, THE DIVISION ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS DESIGNEE SHALL PAY:
- (I) THE COST TO THE COUNTY OF PROVIDING FOOD, LODGING, AND CLOTHING FOR THE PARTICIPANT;
  - (II) THE FOOD, TRAVEL, AND OTHER EXPENSES OF THE PARTICIPANT INCIDENTAL TO PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM;
