(3) 1 representative from the Maryland Association of Counties and 1 representative from the Maryland Municipal League, both of whom are appointed by the Governor;

(4) 1 representative of the Agronomy Department of the University of Maryland, appointed by the Governor;

(5) 1 representative of the Environmental Engineering Department of the Johns Hopkins University, appointed by the Governor;

(6) 1 member from the State Water Quality Advisory Council;
