- (10) Recommendations for effective public education and public input programs; and
- damage to land, water resources, and animals from the spreading of sludge on land with a State permit; and be it further be-it-further

RESOLVED, That the Commission be composed of:

- (1) -2-3 members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Delegates, and -2-3 members of the Senate, appointed by the President of the Senate; and
- $\ \,$  (2) 1 representative of each of the following departments, appointed by the Secretary of the appropriate department:
- (i) Department of Health and Mental Hygiene;
  - (ii) Department of Natural Resources;
  - (iii) Department of State Planning;
- (iv) Department of Economic and Community Development;
  - (v) State Department of Agriculture; and
  - (Vi)--State-Department--of--Transportation.
- (3) 1 representative from the Maryland Association of Counties and 1 representative from the Maryland Municipal League, both of whom are appointed by the Governor;
- (4) 1 representative of the Agronomy Department of the University of Maryland, appointed by the Governor;
- $\,$  (5) 1 representative of the Environmental Engineering Department of the Johns Hopkins University, appointed by the Governor;
- (6) 1 member from the State Water Quality Advisory Council;
- (6) (7) 1 member from the Maryland farming community, appointed by the Governor;
- (7) (8) 1 member representing sewage sludge generators, appointed by the Governor;
