property or in-kind contributions. In case of any dispute as to what money or assets may qualify as the applicant's matching fund, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's decision shall be final. Loyola College shall have until June 1, 1984, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that this fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence of the raising of at least an equal and matching fund for this project is presented to the Board of Public Works on or before June 1, 1984, the Board of Public Works shall so certify to the Treasurer of the State and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended in accordance with the provisions of this Act. If satisfactory evidence of the raising of at least an equal and matching fund for this project is not presented to the Board of Public Works on or before June 1, 1984, the proceeds of the loan shall be applied to the purposes authorized in Article 78A, § 3 of the Code.

(6) No portion of the proceeds of the loan or any of the matching funds may be used for the furtherance of sectarian religious instruction, or in connection with the design, acquisition, or construction of any building used or to be used as a place of sectarian religious worship or used or to be used as a place for sectarian religious instruction, or in connection with any part of any program or department of divinity for any religious denomination. Upon the request of the Board of Public Works, Loyola College shall submit evidence satisfactory to the Board that none of the proceeds of this loan or any of the matching funds have been or are being used for a purpose prohibited by this Act.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1982.

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 392.

This bill authorizes the creation of a State debt. The proceeds will be used to assist in the planning, design, construction and equipping of the addition and renovation of the Physical Plant Building and for academic offices and classrooms in the building known as the College Center located at Loyola College.
