Preamble

WHEREAS, the Lida Lee Tall School has educated students since 1866 and was established as a model elementary school in 1933; and

WHEREAS, the Lida Lee Tall School is being continued in order to serve as a learning resource center; and

WHEREAS, the State does not have a learning resource center independent of an institution of higher education; and

THEREFORE, The Lida Lee Tall Learning Resource Center is placed, at the outset, under the Education Coordinating Committee, and the General Assembly expects a review which will propose a permanent governance structure by January 1, 1984; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland read(s) as follows:

Article - Education

5-202.

(a) (7) "Students" or "students enrolled" means:

(i) All students enrolled in grades 1 through 12 or their equivalent in regular day school programs on September 30 of the previous school year, [and in Baltimore County includes] INCLUDING the students in the
