In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 855.

This bill extends the time from 7 to 15 days in which a motion may be filed for a rehearing following the date of the decision of the Workmen's Compensation Commission.

House Bill 1399, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on June 1, 1982, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore, it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 855.
