This bill authorizes the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$1,500,000, the proceeds to be used for the continuation of the planning, design, and construction of the Maryland Concert Center in Baltimore, Maryland subject to the requirement that the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra Association provide at least an equal and matching fund for the same purpose.

House Bill 1832, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 20, 1982 accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 967.

Senate Bill No. 981

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Rail Property Rehabilitation

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$2,075,000 \$1,000,000 \$750,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to Worcester County for improvement and rehabilitation of property real property,-personal-property,-and-property-rights-of-any kind in the Dagsboro, Delaware to Snow Hill rail facility; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That:

(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Rail Property Rehabilitation Loan of 1982 in the aggregate principal amount of \$2,075,000 \$1,000,000. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance and sale of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold and delivered in accordance with the provisions of §§ 19 to 23 of Article 31 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1976 Replacement Volume and 1981 Supplement, as amended from time to time).
