

satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that the matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State Treasurer and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. If this evidence is not presented by June 1, 1984 the proceeds of the loan shall be ~~transferred to the Annuity Bond Fund and applied to the debt service requirements of the State~~ applied to the purposes authorized in Article 78A, § 3 of the Code.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1982.

Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed Senate Bill 989.

This bill authorizes the creation of a State Debt to be used as a grant to the Mayor and City Council of Hagerstown for the renovation and improvement of the Hagerstown Municipal Stadium.

House Bill 98, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 4, 1982, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore it is not necessary for me to sign Senate Bill 989.
