Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 494.

This bill includes previous service time with the State or with a public school as a teacher for credit towards eligibility for benefits in the State Employees' and Teachers' Pension Systems.

Senate Bill 278, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on June 1, 1982, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 494.

AN ACT concerning

Pensions - Error Correction and Obsolete Phrase Repeal

FOR the purpose of correcting certain errors and repealing certain obsolete phrases in the Pensions Article; and providing that this Act is not intended to affect any law other than to correct technical errors.
