FOR the purpose of altering the status of a court order waiving exclusive jurisdiction of a juvenile court with respect to petitions alleging delinquency so that such an order is interlocutory rather--than under certain circumstances, and immediately appealable under certain other circumstances.

- (a) The court may waive the exclusive jurisdiction conferred by \S 3-804 with respect to a petition alleging delinquency by:
 - (1) A child who is 15 years old or older, or
- (2) A child who has not reached his 15th birthday, but who is charged with committing an act which if committed by an adult, would be punishable by death or life imprisonment.
