In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, I have today vetoed House Bill 933.

This bill establishes a pilot program to provide financial assistance for certain disabled persons in need of certain services.

Senate Bill 338, which was passed by the General Assembly and signed by me on June 1, 1982, accomplishes the same purpose. Therefore it is not necessary for me to sign House Bill 933.

AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County - Orphans' Court -
Salaries of Judges and Bailiffs
