FOR the purpose of altering-the-fiseal-year-used-te ealeulate-the-State-share-of-basic-current-expenses-te public-education; providing-that-certain-State-aid-may not-be-less-than-aid-received-during-a-certain-fiseal year providing that in addition to the State share of basic current expenses, certain counties shall receive hold harmless aid in fiscal year 1983; and generally relating to State financial aid to public education.
