THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND THEIR TERMS OF OFFICE SHALL BE AS THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL DETERMINES.

- (A) MEETINGS.
- (1) THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL SHALL MEET AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT IT DETERMINES.
- (2) AT LEAST 2 MEETINGS A YEAR SHALL BE HELD JOINTLY WITH THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON ALCOHOLISM CONTROL AND THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL ON DRUG ABUSE.
 - (B) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.

A MEMBER OF THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL:

- (1) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION; BUT
- (2) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
 - (C) STAFF SERVICES.

THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PROVIDE SECRETARIAL, CONSULTANT, AND OTHER STAFF SERVICES TO THE STATE ADVISORY COUNCIL.
