

(2) DEVELOP GUIDELINES FOR ESTABLISHING LOCAL OR REGIONAL COMMITTEES TO COORDINATE THE PROGRAM; AND

(3) COORDINATE SERVICES TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1982.
