- (i) It is designated and shall act as the single State agency to monitor and enforce compliance with all requirements of the Federal Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974 and 1980 as amended.
- (j) It is designated and shall act as the single State agency for the planning, use, award, and administration of crime control funds appropriated by new Federal programs.
- (k) It shall be available to advise the Governor on criminal justice and juvenile justice budget requests to insure a well coordinated State criminal justice program.
- (1) It shall undertake and perform all other such duties and functions in the area of law enforcement and the administration of justice which may be necessary for it to carry out the provisions of any of the duties and powers within this Executive Order.
- (m) It may adopt rules for internal management consistent with this Executive Order.

INTER-DEPARTMENTAL COMMITTEE FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS MASTER PLANNING

- WHEREAS, The State of Maryland is an extensive user of telecommunications equipment and service; and
- WHEREAS, The existing Telecommunications Master Plan, which was developed in 1969, has been made obsolete by recent deregulation initiatives by the Department of Justice, by the emergence of the interconnect industry, and by advances in telecommunications technology; and
- WHEREAS, The effective use of telecomunications can improve the efficiency of State Government and increase its responsiveness to the needs of its citizens;
