(c) "Dependent child" means a needy person who -{-is either (1) under the age of eighteen years or (2) under the age of _[twenty-one years and (as determined by the Social Services Administration in accordance with standards prescribed by the Secretary of Health, Education and Welfare) is a student regularly attending a school, college or university, or regularly attending a course of vocational or technical training designed to fit him for gainful employment,] (+)-MEETS-THE-ASE-AND-EDUCATIONAL--REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED--BY--REGULATIONS--OF--THE--DEPARTMENT--OF--HUMAN RESOURCES 19 YEARS AND IS A FULL-TIME STUDENT ENROLLED IN A PROGRAM AT A SECONDARY SCHOOL OR IN THE EQUIVALENT LEVEL OF
