

RESOLUTION of the Council of the Town of Bladensburg to amend the Charter of the Town of Bladensburg, this amendment to be entitled "Annual Tax Rate", such being the 2nd. amendment to the Charter by striking that the amount of taxes levied for any fiscal year not exceed seventy-five cents (\$.75) on the one hundred dollar (\$100.00) assessed property valuation and to provide that the amount of taxes levied for any fiscal year shall be set annually by resolution of the Council.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOWIE, MARYLAND adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11E of the Constitution of Maryland and Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition, as amended) to amend Section 16 entitled "(Salary of the Mayor)", said Section being Section 5-16 of Subtitle 5 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland (1963 Edition, as amended), which article contains in whole or in part the Charter of the City of Bowie, by repealing and re-enacting with amendment said Section 16 increasing from \$5,100.00 to \$6,000.00 the salary for Mayor.
