RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF CECILTON, ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF ARTICLE III and ARTICLE XI E OF THE CONSTITUTION OF MARYLAND, SECTION 13, OF ARTICLE 23A OF THE ANNOTATED CODE OF MARYLAND, 1957 EDITION, 1973 REPLACEMENT VOLUME, TITLE "CORPORATIONS-MUNICIPAL" TO REPEAL SECTION 308 OF THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF CECILTON, CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND AS ADOPTED FEBRUARY 21, 1979 AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 308 OF THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF CECILTON AS AMENDED, SAID RESOLUTION CONSTITUTES AN AMENDMENT TO THE MUNICIPAL CHARTER OF THE BODY POLITIC AND CORPORATE KNOWN AS THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF CECILTON.
