A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT AMENDMENTS TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF NEW CARROLLTON, PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND (SECTION 9 OF ARTICLE 17, OF THE CODE OF PUBLIC LOCAL LAWS OF MARYLAND, EVERSTINE'S 1963 EDITION, AS AMENDED) AMENDING SUBSECTION 3.b.(2.), ENTITLED "ELECTED OFFICIALS: VACANCIES," OF SECTION 3 OF SAID CHARTER, ENTITLED "GOVERNMENT OF THE CITY;" SUBSECTION 7.a., ENTITLED "CONDUCT AND PROCEDURES," OF SECTION 7 OF SAID CHARTER, ENTITLED "ELECTIONS;" SUBSECTION 7.b., ENTITLED "NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES," OF SECTION 7 OF SAID CHARTER, ENTITLED "ELECTIONS;" AND SUBSECTION 7.d., ENTITLED "CANDIDATES ELECTED," OF SECTION 7 OF SAID CHARTER, ENTITLED "ELECTIONS," TO PROVIDE THAT A SPECIAL ELECTION SHALL BE HELD WITHIN A PRESCRIBED PERIOD IF A VACANCY OCCURS IN THE OFFICE OF COUNCILMEMBER.
