 - (2) THESE GUIDELINES SHALL COVER:
 - (I) DETECTION;
 - (II) CASE FINDING;
 - (III) DIAGNOSIS;

 - (V) THERAPY;
 - (VI) LONG TERM MANAGEMENT; AND

(VII) ANY OTHER SERVICES THAT THE COMMISSION THINKS SHOULD BE COVERED.
