

(2) SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT OF THE EVALUATION TO RNOR.

13-307. RULES, REGULATIONS, AND STANDARDS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, THE COMMISSION MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) STANDARDS FOR CENTERS.

THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT PHYSICAL AND MEDICAL STANDARDS FOR THE OPERATION OF DIALYSIS AND TRANSPLANT CENTERS.

(C) STANDARDS FOR PATIENTS.

(1) THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REASONABLE STANDARDS FOR ACCEPTANCE OF AN INDIVIDUAL FOR TREATMENT.

(2) THE COMMISSION MAY NOT ADOPT ANY STANDARD THAT PREVENTS AN INDIVIDUAL FROM RECEIVING FEDERAL MEDICAL OR FINANCIAL AID.

(D) PAYMENTS FOR OUT-OF-STATE CARE.

THE COMMISSION MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR:

(1) PAYMENT FOR TREATMENT THAT IS GIVEN OUTSIDE THIS STATE; AND

(2) APPROVAL OR DISAPPROVAL, FOR PURPOSES OF STATE PAYMENT UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, OF A DIALYSIS OR TRANSPLANT CENTER THAT IS OUTSIDE THIS STATE.

(E) EXCLUSIVE POWER OF COMMISSION.
