13-409. LIMITATIONS ON SECRETARY.

(A) PLANS, PROPOSALS, AND PROJECTS.

THE POWER OF THE SECRETARY OVER PLANS, PROPOSALS, AND PROJECTS OF UNITS IN THE DEPARTMENT DOES NOT INCLUDE THE POWER TO DISAPPROVE OR MODIFY ANY DECISION OR DETERMINATION THAT THE STATE COMMISSION MAKES UNDER AUTHORITY SPECIFICALLY DELEGATED BY LAW TO THE STATE COMMISSION.

(B) STAFF, FUNCTIONS, AND FUNDS.

THE POWER OF THE SECRETARY TO TRANSFER BY RULE, REGULATION, OR WRITTEN DIRECTIVE, ANY STAFF, FUNCTION, OR FUNDS OF UNITS IN THE DEPARTMENT DOES NOT APPLY TO ANY STAFF, FUNCTION, OR FUNDS OF THE STATE COMMISSION.

This section is rephrased to exclude the State Commission from the general powers of the Secretary under § 2-104(f) and (h) of this article.
