14-105. LICENSE REQUIRED.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, A PERSON SHALL BE LICENSED BY A HEALTH OFFICER BEFORE THE PERSON MAY OPERATE A GROUP DAY CARE CENTER IN THIS STATE.

(B) EXCEPTION.

THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A FAMILY CARE HOME LICENSED UNDER ARTICLE 88A, § 32A OF THE CODE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is new language derived without substantive change from former Article 43, § 709 and rephrased in standard language to state affirmatively that a person must be licensed to operate a group day care center. See also § 14-113 of this subtitle.

14-106. APPLICATIONS FOR LICENSES.

(A) IN GENERAL.

AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE HEALTH OFFICER FOR THE COUNTY WHERE THE GROUP DAY CARE CENTER IS TO BE LOCATED, ON THE FORM THAT THE SECRETARY REQUIRES.
