

(A) TERM OF LICENSE.

EACH LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF ITS EFFECTIVE DATE, UNLESS THE LICENSE IS RENEWED FOR A 1-YEAR TERM AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION.

(B) APPLICATIONS FOR RENEWAL.

BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES, THE LICENSEE PERIODICALLY MAY RENEW IT FOR AN ADDITIONAL 1-YEAR TERM, IF THE LICENSEE MEETS THE CURRENT REQUIREMENTS FOR A NEW LICENSE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the third sentence of former Article 43, § 711.

The former phrase "unless sooner revoked or suspended" is deleted as unnecessary.

14-110. LICENSE NOT TRANSFERABLE.

A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IS NOT TRANSFERABLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section formerly appeared as the second sentence of Article 43, § 711.

The former word "assignable" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the word "transferable".

14-111. SUSPENSIONS AND REVOCATIONS; INJUNCTIONS.

(A) AUTHORITY TO DENY.

SUBJECT TO THE HEARING REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, A HEALTH OFFICER MAY DENY A LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT OR DENY APPROVAL FOR A CHANGE UNDER § 14-108 OF THIS SUBTITLE IF THE APPLICANT OR PROPOSED CHANGE DOES NOT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) AUTHORITY TO SUSPEND OR REVOKE.

(1) SUBJECT TO THE HEARING REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION AND § 14-112 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE SECRETARY MAY SUSPEND OR REVOKE A LICENSE IF THE LICENSEE:

(1) VIOLATES A PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE OR ANY RULE OR REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER IT; OR
