(C) ELDERLY INDIVIDUAL.

"ELDERLY INDIVIDUAL" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:

- (1) IS 60 YEARS OLD OR OLDER;
- (2) LIVES ALONE OR WITH A SPOUSE, FAMILY RELATIVE, OR FRIEND; AND
- (3) NEEDS TEMPORARY SUPERVISION AND CARE DURING A PART OF A DAY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection formerly appeared as Article 43, § 717B(2).

The noun phrase "elderly individual" is substituted for "elderly", as the defined term, to avoid the grammatical inconsistency of the former definition, which defined the adjective "elderly" to mean "a person".

In item (2) of this subsection, the former reference to "his or her child" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the reference to a "family relative".

14-202. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE; INTENT.

(A) STATEMENT OF PURPOSE.

THE PURPOSES OF THIS SUBTITLE ARE:
