15-112. SAME -- PHYSICIANS.

AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE STATE BOARD OF PHARMACY, THE SECRETARY MAY AUTHORIZE REIMBURSEMENT OF A PHYSICIAN FOR THE DISPENSING OF DRUGS TO PROGRAM RECIPIENTS, ON THE SAME BASIS AS A LICENSED PHARMACIST IF:

(1) THE PHYSICIAN DISPENSES DRUGS ON A REGULAR BASIS IN THE PHYSICIAN'S OFFICE; AND

(2) THERE IS NO PHARMACY WITHIN 10 MILES OF THAT OFFICE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section formerly appeared as Article 43, § 42P.

The defined term "physician", which refers to an individual authorized to practice medicine in this State, is substituted for the ambiguous reference to a "licensed physician".

15-113. SAME -- PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS.

(A) "INMATE OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "INMATE OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN TITLE 42, § 435.1009 OF THE CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS (1978 EDITION).

(B) PAYMENT REQUIRED.
