DEPARTMENT SHALL PAY THE CUSTODIAL AUTHORITY FOR ANY MEDICAL CARE THAT IS PROVIDED TO THE INMATE DURING THE MONTH WHEN THE INDIVIDUAL BECAME AN INMATE.

- (2) PAYMENTS UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPLICABLE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE PROGRAM.
 - (C) REIMBURSEMENT.

THE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE REIMBURSED FOR THE NONFEDERAL COST OF MEDICAL CARE BY EITHER THE STATE OR LOCAL AUTHORITY THAT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE INMATE OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION.

 - (A) "RELATED INSTITUTION" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "RELATED INSTITUTION" INCLUDES ANY OF THE FOLLOWING FACILITIES, AS CLASSIFIED FROM TIME TO TIME BY LAW, RULE, OR REGULATION:

- (1) A COMPREHENSIVE CARE FACILITY.
- (2) AN EXTENDED CARE FACILITY.
- (3) AN INTERMEDIATE CARE FACILITY.
- (4) A SKILLED NURSING FACILITY.
- (B) SCOPE OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION:

- (1) APPLIES ONLY TO THE EXTENT THAT FEDERAL FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE, FOR REIMBURSEMENT UNDER THIS SECTION; AND
 - (2) EXPIRES ON JUNE 30, 1983.
 - (C) REIMBURSEMENT REQUIRED.

THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REIMBURSE, IN THE SAME MANNER THAT HOSPITALS ARE REIMBURSED UNDER THE PROGRAM, EACH FACILITY
