

DEPARTMENT SHALL PAY THE CUSTODIAL AUTHORITY FOR ANY MEDICAL CARE THAT IS PROVIDED TO THE INMATE DURING THE MONTH WHEN THE INDIVIDUAL BECAME AN INMATE.

(2) PAYMENTS UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPLICABLE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE PROGRAM.

(C) REIMBURSEMENT.

THE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE REIMBURSED FOR THE NONFEDERAL COST OF MEDICAL CARE BY EITHER THE STATE OR LOCAL AUTHORITY THAT IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE INMATE OF A PUBLIC INSTITUTION.

15-114. SAME -- RELATED INSTITUTIONS.

(A) "RELATED INSTITUTION" DEFINED.

IN THIS SECTION, "RELATED INSTITUTION" INCLUDES ANY OF THE FOLLOWING FACILITIES, AS CLASSIFIED FROM TIME TO TIME BY LAW, RULE, OR REGULATION:

- (1) A COMPREHENSIVE CARE FACILITY.
- (2) AN EXTENDED CARE FACILITY.
- (3) AN INTERMEDIATE CARE FACILITY.
- (4) A SKILLED NURSING FACILITY.

(B) SCOPE OF SECTION.

THIS SECTION:

(1) APPLIES ONLY TO THE EXTENT THAT FEDERAL FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE, FOR REIMBURSEMENT UNDER THIS SECTION; AND

(2) EXPIRES ON JUNE 30, 1983.

(C) REIMBURSEMENT REQUIRED.

THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REIMBURSE, IN THE SAME MANNER THAT HOSPITALS ARE REIMBURSED UNDER THE PROGRAM, EACH FACILITY
