 - (A) ELIGIBILITY FOR PROGRAM.
- (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAINTAIN A MARYLAND PHARMACY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR LOW INCOME INDIVIDUALS WHOSE:
- (I) ASSETS ARE NOT MORE THAN THE ASSET SCHEDULE OF THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM; AND
- (II) GROSS ANNUAL INCOME IS NOT MORE THAN \$1,700 OVER THE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE INCOME SCHEDULE.
- (2) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE SECRETARY SHALL:
 - (I) DEFINE EXCLUDED ASSETS;

(B) REIMBURSEMENT.

- (1) THE MARYLAND PHARMACY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM SHALL REIMBURSE PROVIDERS FOR THOSE KINDS OF ITEMS AND SERVICES THAT ARE COVERED BY THE PHARMACY PROGRAM OF THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.
- (2) THE REIMBURSEMENT SHALL BE UP TO THE AMOUNT PAID FOR THE SAME ITEMS OR SERVICES UNDER THE PHARMACY PROGRAM OF THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM AND SUBJECT TO A COPAYMENT OF NOT MORE THAN \$1 FOR EACH COVERED ITEM OR SERVICE.
