17-204. ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES.

THE SECRETARY:

- (1) SHALL SET REASONABLE FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF PERMITS; AND
- (2) MAY SET A FEE FOR THE PROFICIENCY TEST PROGRAM.
 - REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the thirteenth sentence of former Article 43, § 34(a) and the first sentence of (d).

17-205. PERMIT REQUIRED; EXCEPTIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBTITLE, A PERSON SHALL HOLD A PERMIT ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY BEFORE THE PERSON MAY:

- (1) OPERATE A MEDICAL LABORATORY IN THIS STATE;
- (2) REPRESENT OR SERVICE IN THIS STATE ANY MEDICAL LABORATORY THAT IS OUTSIDE THIS STATE.
