

EXCEPT FOR A PHYSICIAN OR A DENTIST, A PERSON MAY NOT:

(1) TREAT OR PRESCRIBE A TREATMENT FOR CANCER;
OR

(2) REPRESENT TO THE PUBLIC THAT THE PERSON CAN CURE, TREAT, OR PRESCRIBE A TREATMENT FOR CANCER.

(B) DISPENSING DRUGS, MEDICINES, AND DEVICES.

A PERSON MAY NOT SELL, OFFER TO SELL, OR GIVE AWAY A DRUG, MEDICINE, OR DEVICE THAT THE MANUFACTURER OR SELLER REPRESENTS AS A CANCER CURE UNLESS A PHYSICIAN OR DENTIST PRESCRIBES THE DRUG, MEDICINE, OR DEVICE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from former Article 43, § 133(a) and (b).

In subsection (b) of this section, the former words "compound" and "nostrum" are deleted as unnecessary.

Former Article 43, § 133(c), which defined the term "cancer", is deleted as unnecessary.

18-302. AMYGDALIN.

(A) USE AUTHORIZED.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A PHYSICIAN MAY PRESCRIBE OR ADMINISTER AMYGDALIN TO TREAT CANCER.

(B) RESTRICTIONS ON USE.

(1) A HOSPITAL OR HEALTH FACILITY MAY NOT RESTRICT OR PROHIBIT THE USE OF AMYGDALIN THAT A PHYSICIAN, WITH THE CONSENT OF A PATIENT, PRESCRIBES FOR OR ADMINISTERS TO THE PATIENT.

(2) (I) THE DEPARTMENT MAY RESTRICT OR PROHIBIT THE USE OF AMYGDALIN IN THE TREATMENT OF A PATIENT IF, AFTER A HEARING, THE DEPARTMENT FINDS THAT THE MANNER IN WHICH THE AMYGDALIN IS PRESCRIBED OR ADMINISTERED IS HARMFUL TO THE PATIENT.

(II) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR HEARINGS UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH.
